

WIC Committees

Baby Showers - Hosts baby showers for first-time moms of all our new covenant children.

Meals for New Moms – Coordinates volunteers to take meals to new moms within WRPC.

Funerals - Helps with onsite funeral arrangements and meals.

Hospitality - Coordinates hospitality gatherings throughout the year.

Meals on Wheels - Volunteers from WRPC meet at the Meals on Wheels office at 15 Oregon Street each 5th Friday to pack meals for those in need throughout Greenville. On average this amounts to about five times during the year. Packing meals begins at 9:00 a.m. and usually ends between 10:30-11:00 a.m. This project provides a way to serve both our church and those in need of food in our community.

Mercy Care Team - Organizes meals and other care needs for families with long-term or immediate illness, or for families who have experienced the death of a close family member.

Military Ministry - Puts together and sends care packages and cards to members of WRPC who are serving in the armed forces.

Widow Ministry - Serves as a support system for the widows of WRPC. This group seeks to meet to share experiences, prayer, and fellowship.

Missions - Strives to provide care and communication with the WRPC supported missionary wives and their families. This may include preparing gift boxes, making prayer cards, sending regular emails, birthday and anniversary cards to the family. This committee's goal is to help our missionary families feel connected to WRPC personally by emailing frequently and getting to know them and their needs and praying for them.

Poundings - Hosts a fellowship style event to help fill the pantry of soon-to-be-married couples.

Women's Conference - Meets throughout the year to plan the annual WIC Conference.

Visitation - Visits and encourages church members who are homebound and are suffering long-term illnesses.

Prayer - Meets in the ladies' parlor on the first and third Monday's of the month. Ladies are welcome to come any or every time. Sorry, no childcare provided.

Welcoming - Assists in welcoming visitors to WRPC by extending fellowship and a meal in someone's home.

Sunday School - Our children's Sunday School ministry is always in need of volunteers to teach Sunday School, be a teacher's assistant, or to be placed on the sub list.

Nursery - Nursery volunteers serve on a six-week rotation basis. Extra hands are always welcome.

Prayer Pals - Anyone can volunteer to partner with a girl in the congregation for prayer, fellowship, and for providing a role model to the girl.
